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AIM reminds residents to clear snow and ice

CORNING | AIM Independent Living Center is reminding the public to promptly clear snow and ice from sidewalks, which are vital transportation routes for many members of the community.

“Property and business owners have a responsibility to ensure that their sidewalks are passable,” said John Zick, AIM’s governmental and public affairs coordinator. “For some, a snow-covered sidewalk is nothing more than a sloppy inconvenience. For others, snow is an impassable obstacle that significantly impacts daily life.”

AIM, a Southern Tier nonprofit organization that helps individuals with disabilities lead independent lives, has received several complaints of impassable sidewalks already this winter.
